Sounds like it will be a really fun rally! There's really a lot to see and do in the Charleston area, a list of which the hosts have forwarded to us, so we're looking forward to this rally, and hopefully we can get some really great seafood while we're there. The cookout that the hosts are doing on Friday night sounds yummy, too.

Also, let me remind everyone to please bring your own plates, utensils, and BYOB for each meal. This applies to ALL rallies.

The March rally is also shaping up to be a fun time. The info for that rally, that I received last night from the hosts, Scott and Clare Herrick, are as follows:

The rally fee will be \$15 per <u>couple</u>, and please send your checks to Scott Herrick, 1304 Jeffery Lane, Bainbridge, GA 39817.

Scott also said to please bring your own bug spray, that Bainbridge is in the "gnat belt," but maybe it won't be the time for gnats yet. Just best to be prepared.

Thursday evening, we are on our own as far as meals. The manager of the <u>Camp has</u> volunteered to provide a fish fry, which will be on Friday night at the park's hall.

Friday, the hosts recommend that folks take the opportunity to go check out the Woodruff Dam and East Bank RV Park, administered by the Corps of Engineers, both in Chattahoochee, just down the road. East Bank will require a Senior's Pass on a hang tag to tour. While in Chattahoochee, if you have built up an appetite, the small restaurant called Rutabaga Cafe is fantastic!

Bainbridge is noted for being the gateway to Lake Seminole, and many fishing tournaments are run from the expansive dock system across the road from the Camp. I have a fairly large pontoon, and if people are interested and let me know ahead of time, I will take small groups for tours of the river on Friday, weather permitting.

Saturday morning, breakfast of scrambled eggs, biscuits and gravy will be provided.

Saturday afternoon will be the best time to attend the play "Swamp Gravy," a nationally recognized theater presentation. There are afternoon performances and evening performances, but our preference is for the Saturday matinee performance, which some of us have already bought tickets for. 5450. The play is held at Cotton Hall Theater in Colquitt, GA. <u>You are strongly advised to</u> make your reservations ASAP for the play, because it sells out fast!

Allow yourself time to tour Colquitt! The quaint town is noted for the "Swamp Gravy" play, but also for the amazing murals that decorate several large structures throughout the area, so a tour would be great.

There are limited resources for dining in Bainbridge, outside the standards, but a new place has just opened up and we are excited to experience it. I will have better plans on this later, but for now, the River City Grill and Pizzeria is my selection for Saturday night dinner.
