**November 4-7, 2021:** St. Augustine, FL. Compass RV Resort, 1505 State Road 207, St. Augustine, FL 32086. Scott has reserved 10 sites. Mention you are with Funseekers Rally. Discount available if we fill 10 sites. Host: **Bill and Ellen Guettler.** 

<u>IMPORTANT</u>: For Reservations call 904-824-3574 and speak only to Barbara Slifer with Compass RV Resort. Barbara works Monday – Wednesday only. She handles reservations for Rallies. If you get a recording leave a message for Barbara and she will call you back.

At each rally Scott reserved 10 sites usually in a general area but not guaranteed. Hopefully, we will exceed 10 participants but if you wait too late to book the availability of sites may be gone or limited. You are responsible for reserving your site. Each rally participant is required to sign the FMCA Covid19 waiver. No exceptions. We will continue to practice Covid19 protection protocol. When you are booking reservations inquire about discounts like Good Sam or Veteran, if applicable.
